Praise—Praising God for **who He is.** His attributes. His name or His character

Attribute—God is Victorious
Definition —the state of having triumphed; one who overcomes in a battle or struggle
Scripture(s)—Exodus 15:2-3; Psalm 48:10; Psalm 62:1-2; Isaiah 42:12-13; 1 Chronicles 29:11 (See reverse side)
(All Scripture quotations on both sides of this prayer sheet are taken from the New Liviing Translation.)
Thoughts
Silent Confession —Silently confessing your sins to the God who forgives For sin is the sting that results in death, and the law gives sin its power. But thank God! He gives us victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Corinthians 15:56-58
Thanksgiving —Thanking God for what He has done (Please no prayer requests during this time.) The Lord is my strength and my song; He has given me victory. Songs of joy and victory are sung in the camp of the godly. The strong right arm of the Lord has done glorious things! Psalm 118:14-15
Intercession—Coming to God in prayer on behalf of others (Form groups of two or three.)
Our Own Children—Each mom chooses one child.

Teachers/Staff

Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. For we are not fighting against fleshand-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. Additional Scriptures:

Psalm 62:6-8—He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress where I will not be shaken. My victory and honor come from God alone. He is my refuge, a rock where no enemy can reach me. O my people, trust in him at all times. Pour out your heart to him, for God is our refuge.

Psalm 18:34-36—He trains my hands for battle; he strengthens my arm to draw a bronze bow. You have given me your shield of victory. Your right hand supports me; your help has made me great. You have made a wide path for my feet to keep them from slipping.

2 Corinthians 10:3-4—We are human, but we don't wage war as humans do. We use God's mighty weapons, not worldly weapons, to knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments.

Exodus 14:14—The LORD himself will fight for you. Just stay calm.

2 Chronicles 20:17a—But you will not even need to fight. Take your positions; then stand still and watch the LORD's victory.

Psalm 34:6-7—In my desperation I prayed, and the LORD listened; he saved me from all my troubles. For the angel of the LORD is a guard; he surrounds and defends all who fear him.

Zechariah 4:6b—"It is not by force nor by strength, but by my Spirit," says the LORD of Heaven's Armies.

Jeremiah 32:17—O Sovereign LORD! You made the heavens and earth by your strong hand and powerful arm. Nothing is too hard for you!

Psalm 140:6-7—I said to the LORD, "You are my God!" Listen, O LORD, to my cries for mercy! O Sovereign LORD, the strong one who rescued me, you protected me on the day of battle.

Psalm 32:7—For you are my hiding place; you protect me from trouble. You surround me with songs of victory.
